The 1921 Newfoundland general census for Bay Roberts lists the Elms family as follows: William age 45, Dinah 28, children William jr. 8, Florence 6 and Clement 1. Also living in the home was mother Sarah

Elms age 76, as well as Uncle Stephen Vey at 58.

At the next census taking in 1935, the Elms family now included three (3) more children. Parents William and Dinah are 60 and 42, respectively. William jr. is 22, Florence 20, Clement 16, Herman 11, Clarence 6, and Lorne 4.

Clement enlisted in the RAF on the 21st of August 1940 and served until the end of the war. He was a member of the 1st Draft for RAF Air Crew on August 22nd, 1940. He was released from service on 19 July 1946. Upon enlistment, Clement was sent to Canada for training before being shipped overseas.



Back home in Bay Roberts, he is single 25 and at home with his now, widowed mother, Dinah.

Clement married Eillen Caroline Dawe of Coley's Point in 1946, and they moved to

Gander where he took a job with ATC Air Traffic Control and worked there for thirty years or so. Eileen had just graduated as a nurse and went to work at the hospital in Gander. Together they had two sons, Howard, and James.

BACK FROM INDIA—

Warrant Officer Clement L. Elms of the Royal Air Force, arrived here from England last week to spend a two months' leave with his mother. Wm. Elms, and other relatives. After a short training in England, Clem was transferred to the R.A.F. India Command, and has spent the past three years doing operations on the Burma front. He arrived back in England February this year has since been instructing. came across the Atlantic on the liner Queen Mary. He expects to get his final discharge in June next year. There are three other Bay Roberts boys serving var-

ious branches of the R. A. F. in Inda, namely: Jim Kielly, Roy Yetman and Clarence Morgan.
