Although Edward’s service record is not available to the general public as of the time writing this biography, what is known is that he was part of 15<sup>th</sup> Newfoundland Naval Contingent that left Newfoundland in May 1941.

Edward is described in records available as being 5’ 11” tall, of fresh complexion and having brown hair with blue eyes.

The 1935 Newfoundland general census has Edward listed as being just thirteen (13) and living at home in Bay Roberts with his

parents. Then the following events take place:

1. 1939 sees Edward living on the Isle of Wight, England
2. May 1941 Edward arrives in Liverpool England  
Joined the Royal Navy of Great Britian and served until his release in March of 1946.
3. March 1943, he arrives by ship in New York, USA
4. April 1944, he again arrives in New York, USA
5. July 1948, Edward arrives at Detroit, Michigan and just a short while later that month, he moves to Toronto and is living with his bother Charlie.
6. 1951 brings the birth of twin daughters, Marilyn, and Shirley. Sadly, both infants do not survive.
7. December 1953, he married Alfreda Earle of Harbour Grace. They marry in Toronto
8. Jan 1956 sees the birth of a son “Herbie” Charles
9. 1957 the Snows are residents of Rosedale, Ontario
10. 18 Aug 1988: Edward passed away suddenly at St. Michaels Hospital, Toronto.

He is buried at Barrie, Ontario, Canada.
