The 1935 Newfoundland general census lists the Mercer family as living in Shearstown. John is 31 and working as a labourer on the farm. His wife Pearl is 24. They have a son Eugene age 2 years.

At the time of the next general census in 1945, things have changed. The Mercer's are still living in Shearstown, but wife Pearl passed in 1941 and John, now 42, is married to Susan 28. There are six (6) children of

record: Eugene 12, Arthur 9, Susie 7, John 4, Reginald 1, and Samuel, just several months old.

In all Eugene would have five (5) brothers and two (2) sisters.

Eugene spent the better part of twenty-two (22) years in the Royal Canadian Navy, enlisting on 20 October 1952 and retiring from active service on 05 August 1974.

Upon enlistment, Eugene was listed as being 5' 6" tall, of fair complexion with black hair and hazel eyes. He has an identifying scar on his left thumb.

In 1956, September 17 to be precise, Eugene married Alice Keenan on board the HMCS Assiniboine while at Halifax.

Alice was born in Montreal, Quebec and it was when Eugene was stationed there that they met. They were married for 65 years and had two children, John Howard in 1957 and Leanne Dora in 1963. Alice passed in 2021.

Following his Naval service, Eugene returned to Newfoundland and made his home in Shearstown. There he became the postmaster for the town and worked at farming as well.

In 1975, he joined the Royal Canadian Legion at Bay Roberts and was a member of Branch 32 until his death, some 48 years in all. To say he spent a life in service is to state the obvious: 22 years in the Royal Canadian Navy, 48 years in the Royal Canadian Legion, there's 60 years right there and that does not include his service to his beloved Church, St. Mark's Anglican Church at Shearstown.

Eugene passed in August 2023 and is buried at St. Mark's Anglican Churchyard, Shearstown. He was 90 years old.
