Malcolm was born in 1944 at Come by Chance to Edith Cavel Toope of Dark Cove, Bonavista North, and Malcolm Pilgrim. They were nineteen (19) and thirty eight (38) respectively at the time.

At age one (1) young Malcolm was living with Edith's parents, Charles (48) and E. Maude (45) Toope in Dark Cove, Bonavista North, Newfoundland. Dark Cove is near Gambo.

In June 1950, Malcolm became stepbrother to Douglas Edward Greenland. Edith had married Stephen Greenland of Coley's Point, Bay Roberts and they were living in Stephenville.

By 1963, Malcolm was living in Grand Falls, Newfoundland and was then using the surname Pilgrim (his biological father's name).

By 1977, Malcom is found at home in Queensland, Australia and in 1997, he is living in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

It is during the years between 1963 and 1977, most likely, that he spent time in service in the Royal Canadian Navy (RCN), but this is just a best guess scenario.

In 1982, Malcom's biological father (Malcolm Pilgrim) passed away in Griquet, Newfoundland.

Half brother, Edward, died in Toronto in 2009.

Malcolm was married to Janet Young, and they had one daughter of record.

2011 saw the death of his mother at Clarke's Beach, Newfoundland with Malcolm himself passing in March of the same year in Winnipeg, Manitoba. He was sixty-seven at the time.

He is buried in St. John the Evangelist Cemetery at Coley's Point, Newfoundland.
