Since the Service Records for World War 2 Veterans is currently unavailable to the general public, any notation regarding service is a best guess scenario or based on input from family members.

Walter enlisted in the summer of 1941, based on the fact that he was part of the 16<sup>th</sup> Naval Contingent that departed for overseas in July 1941, arriving in the UK on the 8<sup>th</sup> of August 1941.

Walter appears in the 1935 Newfoundland census at age thirteen (13) son of Percy and Ella Taylor of South River, Newfoundland. He is the youngest of six (6) children.

Walter returned home from the war and is found in the 1945 general Newfoundland census living in St. John's as a "roomer" in the home of Michael and Mary Breen of Balsam Street. He is now twenty-five (25) and is married to Dulcie twenty-four (24) of Clarke's Beach.

Walter passed away in late Dec 1978 and wife Dulcie in August 1993. They are buried in the All Saint's Anglican Church Cemetery at South River.
